

Rules and Procedures - PDQ Flyers Field Rules

1. All pilots must have a current MAAC membership. Copies of MAAC and PDQ Flyers membership must be attached to your frequency pin.
2. All MAAC and PDQ Flyers rules must be obeyed at all times. No exceptions.
3. Everyone is required to sign the DND waiver form (one time only).
4. Frequency control is to be used at all times by means of the MAAC frequency board and a frequency pin on the appropriate channel. Transmitters must be kept in the impound when not in use. Be respectful of others; 15 minute flights when you are sharing a frequency.
5. Absolutely no flying behind the flight line.
6. Communicate your intentions LOUDLY so others on the flight line can hear you: "On the field", "Landing from left", "Landing from right", "Taking off from the left", "Taking off from the right". If you get in trouble SHOUT IT OUT.
7. Noise Rules (Electrics Exempt)
 1. All airplanes shall meet a maximum noise requirement of **92 db measured at 6 meters**. The noise meter shall be set to the "A" weighting scale and "slow response" setting.
 2. The noise reading used will be the one measured at the loudest aircraft orientation.
 3. Flying will not commence before 10 a.m. and will end at sunset.
 4. A maximum of 5 aircraft may be airborne at any one time.
 5. After 5:00 p.m., no more than 3 aircraft may be airborne at one time.
 6. Aircraft that are **above 92db but not more than 98 db**, will be allowed to fly only after meeting all of the following conditions:
 1. Only the 1 aircraft is airborne at any one time.
 2. The pilot must get the agreement of all other pilots not to fly at the same time.
 3. No flying of these aircraft after 5:00 p.m. under any circumstances.
8. All garbage must be removed by whoever brought it.
9. Guest may visit the field 3 times a year (excluding events). If you visit more often you are expected to join the club. Current AMA members are welcome.
10. Until pilots have been trained and certified, a qualified Instructor must be beside them at the flight line. Instructors are not to be held responsible for damage to students' equipment if there is an accident.
11. All children and pets must be kept under control at all times; pets on a leash.
12. Absolutely no alcohol is permitted on the premises.
13. Parking in parking lot only; Unload your aircraft at your own risk (MAAC strictly forbids vehicles within 30 metres of the flight line).
14. First one at the field must phone the gate house and let them know the field is in use. The last one to leave must call them and let them know everyone has left the premises.
15. Last one out must lock the gate.

Disciplinary Procedure

Unofficial Step: Individual is spoken to by anybody in the club and/or reported to the safety committee.

Step 1: Safety committee, after evaluating all the facts, gives verbal warning.

Step 2: Written warning from safety committee to the individual, with a copy going to the club and read at the next meeting.

Step 3: Safety committee recommends to the club what form of disciplinary action should be taken against the offender, with the final decision of the penalty being made by club members in the form of a secret ballot.
